- A nutritious snack including pasteurized apple cider and "Guaranteed Peanut-free" cookie

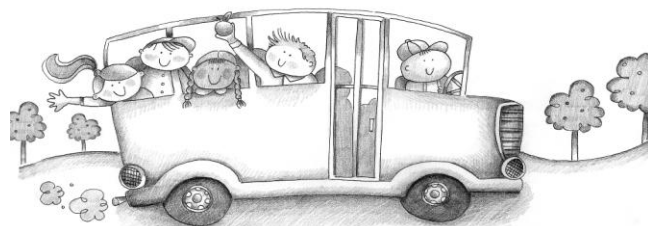
Times, Costs, and Bookings:

Tours are 90 min. duration - first one beginning at 9am and last one starting at 1:30pm. Cost is \$7 (includes hst) per child. Teachers, Organizers, and chaperones are free of charge. Minimum group charge is for 20 children.

Our Lunch time tours are a great way to spend more time on the farm. Lunch tours start as early as 11:15 and last 120 minutes. Cost is \$7.50 (includes hst) per child. Food is not provided - children must bring a brown bag lunch. Teachers and volunteers may purchase lunch in our market bakery. Minimum group charge is for 20 children.

In the event of rain, most of our program can be run under cover. Payment is due at tour time.
